The object of the visit in 1972 was to investigate the sump using breathing apparatus. Trevor Faulkner proved the sump to be 3 meters in diameter and 8 meters long between the air surfaces. On the far side a short beach separated the sump from a third lake. The Third Lake was 29 paces long, less than waist deep and had a bed of soft mud. It was 24 paces from the end of the Third Lake to a choke, with a couple of angular boulders half buried in the dry silt.
