Caving in Yorkshire

On their vacation to England two members of the Norwegian Speleological Society visited David St. Pierre in Yorkshire. There they experienced four different caves in «The Dales». On Ingleborough 723m many caves are hidden below the limestone pavement. Stalactites and stalagmites can be formed like fingers. In «White Scar Cave» you can see «Witches' Finger» and a «Devil's Tongue».

The highlight was the 104 metre winch descent to the bottom of «Gaping Gill». The ride ended next to a waterfall in a large cavern with many side passages.

In the other caves «Alum Pot» and «Great Douk Cave», they followed the streams through colourful and impressive limestone formations.

They will make another visit to explore more of the caves.
