Congeria kusceri is a small clam, up to 22 mm in diameter, that lives in the secluded karst underground cave systems of Croatia and Bosnia-Herzegovina. Like many cave animals, it has evolved numerous adaptations such as albinism, vision loss and extreme longevity.

Congeria kusceri is a rare species and highly endangered due to the impact of human activities on groundwater systems.
