Enkelte grotter og personligheter i Ranadistriktet i 1968

Centred around the NEG expedition in 1968, we meet some characters on the Norwegian caving scene and see how their meetings affe-cted their path the following years. The NEG members had their base camp in Røvassdalen. They went glacier hiking and camped on the ice north of the Arctic Circle. Here they met Karl Johan Westermark, a friend of many British glaciologsists and cavers. NEG was also in-troduced to the James Lovelock, author of two caving-related books. They explored Krystallgrotta together. Their connection results in a book on the British caving expedition to Himalaya in 1970. The NEG members later took part in various caving expeditions in France, Switzerland, Venezuela and New Guinea, Mulu and Sarawak.
