## To huler i Østfold

Bjørnehola is a sea-cave lying just a few kilometres northwest of the Svinesund border-station between Norway and Sweden. Bjørnehola lies on the bottom of a small, boulder filled canyon at the north end of Røssnesåsen around 60 m asl. The cave is about 30 m long and has a top entrance that can be climbed to if the rock is not too wet. The rock is granite.

Bukkehola is a system of tectonic cracks in granite located about a kilometre from main road no. 120 from Moss to Elvestad. The total length of the system is about 30 m.
