The caves of the Glomfjell area

Glomfjellet forms part of an extensive (200 sq. km) limestone outcrop north of Storglomvatnet and the Svartisen ice-caps of Nordland. Lying in Gildeskål and Meløy kommune of Nordland, this upland area is uninhabited but frequently visited by walkers, fishermen and employees of the hydro-electric authorities who have regulated a number of lakes.
