THE NEVERSLETTE-SYSTEMET

In 1984 an expedition from the University of East Anglia visited Glomdal in Rana and discovered a significant new streamway cave system in the marbles between Fisktjørnmoen and Glomdalsvatnet. The underground streamway has a total length (from sink to resurgence) of 1 km; the streamway can be entered in five caves along its length and there is a total of 1475 m of passage in these caves. The large cave (1100 m) at the stream sink was extended in 1984 by Wessex Cave Club and the extension surveyed in 1986 by Speleo-Club Vauban (Lille, France).
