The cave lies two hours by foot and 1800feet above RV. 80 between Mo and Nesna, at Utskarpen. The entrance lies by a waterfall just below the Laupen cliffs, and the main passage continues for some300 yards at the same level parallel with the cliff face. An intriguing question is what happens to the stream which disappears at the entrance? Perhaps it connects with the above-mentioned Purknes river cave.
