Fosshølet

This is a report from a cave diving expedition to Fosshølet in the Svartisen area. Before the diving the expedition members have carried a lot of equipment down to the sump. Three of the members are diving and can tell about a great experience being in the water between white marble. During the diving they entered several sumps and found passages without water. The cave is mainly in a band of marble and varies from narrowed passages to large halls. The author underlines the need of planning and experience before diving.
