This is an active stream cave, also situated in Gråtådal. David St. Pierre and members of Southwest Essex Technical College Caving Club surveyed the cave in 1963. Stop on a parking site on the left hand side, after 2 km on the road into the valley. Walk another 150 meters on the road, and take right by a white house. Then walk uphill this road for 20 minutes, and take right at a small gravel pit on the left hand side. Hike thru the forest down to the river, and follow it upstream. First you find the lower cave. Take the way on to left for it and you're there. Warning! The stream rises quickly with heavy rain!
