Agjagcokka

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The main cave here, Agjagcokka-raige, consists of a vadose meandering passage fed by a middle-sized stream from the nearby glacier, and leading down to phreatic tubes near the resurgence. The connection to the resurgence cave is not proved, but is illustrated by the draught. The cave is beautiful and quite sporting, and there are several short side passages leading to snow-covered entrances.

The marble is repeating itself to the north, and some very small tube caves might be what Foslie cal1s "small formation caves".
